LETTER FROM MARC JOLIN, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

It was a record year for JOIN. Our ten-person outreach and retention team helped 479 people (292 households) move off the streets and into permanent housing. That included an unprecedented number of families (78) and dependent children (118).

We achieved this in no small part thanks to the tremendous generosity of the community. Those of you who supported us in the past continued your support. And we saw a 40% increase in individual and corporate donors over 2006! We also enjoyed important new foundation relationships with the Meyer Memorial Trust and the Maybelle Clark Macdonald Fund (please see pg. 8 for a list contributors).

With these new resources we were able to increase both our staff and financial assistance to people sleeping on the streets. We also expanded our network of community partners, including exciting new relationships with several faith groups like Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church (cooking classes) and Neveh Shalom (celebration nation and mother mentoring).

As we grow, however, we are working hard not to lose touch with the core principles of our service model. These principles are the foundation of our ability to use the scarce resources we have to effectively serve the largest number of people possible:

- Allow each person to define his or her own path off the streets.
- Reinforce that person's strengths by not doing for them what they can do for themselves.
- Make a long-term and personal commitment to providing precisely the relational and material support that the person needs to succeed.

Staying true to these principles requires that we remain extremely flexible and relationship-based at every level of the organization and its operations. And that necessitates having individuals, companies, landlords, community groups, and foundations that lend their support to our somewhat unorthodox, often chaotic, but ultimately successful approach to ending homelessness.

On behalf of all of us at JOIN, and the hundreds of people whose lives you helped change for the better in 2007, thank you! There would be no JOIN without you.



Outreach & Engagement

The Outreach Services Program at JOIN supports the efforts of homeless individuals and families to transition off the streets and into housing. In order to accomplish this, Outreach Workers encourage people to examine the roots of their homelessness, and assist them in confronting the barriers and challenges they face in their search for housing. The JOIN walk-in center helps facilitate this goal by providing basic services.

Placement & Retention

JOIN's retention team works one-on-one with the people we house to help them achieve housing stability. This includes assistance with social security and disability benefits claims, job search help, friendly visits, community-building events, and childcare and transportation support.

Events & Activities

After being successfully housed by JOIN and remaining stable for some time, Susan was able to fulfill her greatest wish and reconnect with her daughter and two grandchildren. Her daughter Dorris and her grandchildren, Andrea and Isaac, were experiencing difficult times and accepted Susan's invitation to stay with her.

Unfortunately, Dorris' presence in the house put Susan's section eight housing benefit in jeopardy, and Dorris and her children had to leave. So Dorris came to JOIN, knowing from her mother's experience that we could offer the support she needed. JOIN paid the application, deposit, and rental fees on an apartment for Dorris and her children, providing the stability that Dorris needed to look for employment and take care of her children. Dorris is working on her GED and dreams of going to law school. Susan is enjoying having her family near. Last Thanksgiving, Dorris hosted Thanksgiving dinner in her home for her mother and several friends that she has made at JOIN.
